International Student Application to UNIMEL

- 1) The applicant should prepare the application documents required and send them to UNIMEL by post or email.
- 2) UNIMEL will manage the application for international students through Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS).
 3) The applicant must pay the application fees after submitting the application for the International Student Pass to the EMGS.

- 4) The application will be completed within a one-month period.
 5) A-level certificate is needed to apply for a degree-level programme and an O-level certificate for a Diploma Application. **English Proficiency Test**

English Proficiency Test

To secureadmission, your English competency must achieve the minimum course requirement as approved by the Malaysian Qualifications Agency (MQA). When applying for a Visa Approval Letter (VAL), student must demonstrate English proficiency by submitting the results of one of the following English language tests:

- 1) IELTS (International English Language Testing System). 4) CAE (Cambridge English: Advanced).
- 2) TOEFL (Test of English as a foreign language).
- 3) PTE-A (Pearson Test of English Academic).
- 5) CPE (Cambridge English: Proficiency).
- 6) MUET (Malaysian University English Test)

Documents Preparation

- Students will need to submit the following documents for the Student Visa to be processed.
- i) 1 passport photo (white background). (35mm x 45mm).
- ii) A copy of your passport. What we need:
- You will be required to submit a copy of your passport. Here's what we need:
- a) Your passport data page (bio-data page which shows your face, name etc)
- All pages with Visa information. We don't need all the pages of your passport. If the page is empty, you do not need to submit it.
- c) Observation page (showing any extensions, clarifications of name, and previous passport numbers)
- d) Passport validity duration must be 18 months and above.

*Note: For one-off Student Pass applications, the recommended validity is 12 months longer than the duration of study. For example, if the duration of the study is 36 months then the recommended passport validity is 48 months

- e) Special Pass or Exit Stamp (if applicable)
- iii) Certified copies of your academic qualifications with a certified translated copy ni English. (If applicable)
- iv) A certified copy of evidence of your English language proficiency.
- v) Students are required to submit a health declaration form to complete the form provided by EMGS.
- vi) Student Personal Application form for visa application form.
- vii) Application form.
- viii) The management cost for the EMGS student pass application process is estimated to be around RM2300, excluding programme fees.

Application Submission

- All applicants are advised to submit their applications at least 8 weeks / 2 months prior to the commencement date of the intake to avoid any unnecessary delay in the admission process. Please complete and submit the International Student application Form with the following documents listed by the UNIMEL International Office.
